

Week Commencing – 26th February 2018

Communication, Language and Literacy

This week we will be reading 'Where The Wild Things Are' by Maurice Sendak. We will also be watching a play of the story by a travelling theatre group who are coming into school on Monday to perform for us. We will be discussing the beginning, middle and end of the story and then creating a class story map.

On Thursday it is World Book Day, please encourage your child to bring in their favourite book (fiction or non-fiction) to share with their friends. The children will be writing a book review about their book. We will be dressing up as wild animals on Thursday to celebrate our 'Where The Wild Things Are/World Book Day' theme. Mrs De'Ath will become Mrs Giraffe for the day!

Maths

This week in maths we will be recapping on the children's knowledge of 2D / 3D shapes and their properties. We will also be working on recognising, ordering and writing numbers from 1 - 20 with a special focus on the tricky teen numbers. As an extra challenge we will be asking the children to have a go at filling in the missing numbers on the 100 square.

Physical Development

We will be taking the children into the hall for PE sessions every Wednesday. We will be continuing to follow our PE scheme, 'Real PE'. Our next 3 week unit is called 'Monkey Business'. We are aiming to develop the children's core strength by practising seated balances.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

The children will be reminded to use our diamond rules.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be encouraged to paint or make a mask of one of the characters from the story 'Where The Wild Things Are'. They will also be given the chance to retell the story using stick puppets.

Understanding the World

We will be finding out about different types of books and traditional stories from all around the world.
