Attendance and Extended Leave

Overall attendance this half-term is **93.5%** which is below our 95% target. An amazing **52** children achieved 100% attendance this half term; a big well done to them!

Thank you to all our families for your ongoing support. We understand that the weather has caused a lot of disruption to attendance this half term. However, a high proportion of school absence is still related to extended leave and holidays taken during term time. Please ensure that trips abroad are planned in the school holidays. The school must be informed if any school days will be missed and a fine could be issued to both parents if leave is taken during term time.

Late Arrivals

Pupils should be in class by 8:50am. Pupils who arrive 20 minutes after the start time (i.e. after 9:10am) and are not in class by the end of registration are marked as late and will need to sign into the late book.

Lateness will affect a pupil's overall attendance mark, not to mention lots of missed learning opportunities.

Parental support is crucial to ensure children attend school on time, every day and reach their full potential. Thank you for your continued support with this.

Important Reminder: Reporting Absences

Please remember that any pupil absences must be reported via telephoning the school office as soon as possible on a morning. If we do not hear from you, then school will contact the numbers listed on the 'Emergency Contact' list we hold in school. A text message will also be sent.

If we still have not heard from a parent/carer by lunchtime, then a home visit may take place.

This is part of our attendance policy.

Important Reminder: Parking

In recent weeks, we have seen an increase in traffic within the local area, largely due to nearby road closures and road works. On some mornings, this has created an influx of cars on Pentland Road and South Street. Please ensure that you are parking with due consideration to others and helping to consider the safety of children and families accessing school, as well as local residents.

Remember:

- Do not park on yellow zig zag lines
- Do not park on double yellow lines
- Do not park within 10m of a road junction
- Do not park over a driveway or drop down kerb
- Do not park on the pavement, as this causes pedestrians to have to walk on the road.

Car Park Access

This is a polite reminder that only cars with permission to access the car park, should be using the car park. If you have been granted access to the school car park, please ensure your engine is switched off when dropping off and picking up your child/children. Leaving your engine running is a safeguarding risk to children and parents. Thank you.

School gates will be open in advance of drop-off and collection times.


Pre-School and Nursery
